HONOUR ROLL POLICY

At the end of each term the school will publish an Honour Roll.

A. ACHIEVEMENT HONOUR ROLL

To be recognized on the Achievement Honour Roll, a student must achieve 80% or above in all courses (not an average) and must be enrolled in four courses.

B. EFFORT

To be recognized on the Effort Honour Roll, a student must demonstrate a consistent and outstanding effort in class. A student must achieve all G's and be enrolled in four settings (3 courses and the Learning Centre as a study block could qualify as a 4th course).

C. HONOURS WITH DISTINCTION

Students achieving 90% or above in 4 courses and all G's.

D. PRINCIPAL'S LIST

Students achieving Principal's Honour Roll (Effort Honour Roll plus Achievement Honour Roll) three out of the four terms will be recognized as having achieved Principal's List standing. These students will be recognized for their outstanding achievement.

Teachers of online students please adhere to the following guidelines for reporting:

- 1. ALL students receive an "I" on first term report card.
- 2. Please indicate in comments percentage of course completed
 - percentage achievement
 - a final deadline for completion of course that should be no later than the last day of the semester
 - any other comments
- 3. If a student is not 50 percent through the course as of the end of Term 1 or 3 respectively follow up with a phone call home to inform parents.
- 4. "I"s will be changed at end of each semester to reflect the FINAL grade that the student has achieved.
- 5. The Principal/Vice Principal will credit students for honour roll even though they have an "I" if they are more than 50 percent finished the course and their grades meet the guidelines.
