BASIS FOR SELECTION:

The LLESS/LLSS PAC is awarding a \$500.00 scholarship to an LLSS graduate who has demonstrated community and school service and involvement, while maintaining doo grades. The PAC scholarship recognizes that, while at LLSS many students achieve and are awarded for their academic success, there are other types of success that often do not receive as much recognition. The purpose of the PAC scholarship is to reward a student, who, in addition to reasonable level of academic success, has excelled in other subject areas or has contributed to the LLSS school and/or community in a meaningful way.

Qualifications:

1. Involvement in the school community – weighting 35%
2. Active in the community at large – weighting 35%
3. Academic effort and achievement – weighting 30%

PROCEDURE:

Submit your application form together with supporting documents to the school office by the deadline date, no later than May 1st. Submit completed applications to the office in an envelope addresses to the “PAC Scholarship Committee”.

LLES/LLSS PAC SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

General:

The LLES/LLSS PAC is awarding a \$500.00 scholarship to an LLSS graduate who has demonstrated community and school service and involvement, while maintaining good grades. The PAC scholarship recognizes that, while at LLSS many students achieve and are awarded for their academic success, there are other types of success that often do not receive as much recognition. The purpose of the PAC scholarship is to reward a student, who, in addition to a reasonable level of academic success, has excelled in other subject areas or has contributed to the LLSS school and/or community in a meaningful way.

Eligibility:

All graduating LLSS students who have attended LLES and/or LLSS for a minimum of 2 years, and will be starting their post-secondary studies within one year of graduation, are eligible to apply.

Qualifications:

Weighting – 35%

Involvement in the school community through participation on teams, in clubs, school activities or performing school services.

Weighting – 35%

Active in the community at large through participation on teams, in clubs, volunteering, or performing community service.

Weighting – 30%

Academic effort and achievement through maintaining a minimum C+ average, and consistent regular attendance.

How to apply:

Submit your application form together with supporting documents to the school office by the deadline date.

Selection:

A parent committee will review all completed applications. Only the recipient will receive notification by June 1st.

Date of Submission: The Committee must receive your application for review **no later than May 1st**. Submit completed applications to the office in an envelope addressed to the “PAC Scholarship Committee”.

Note: The PAC reserves the right to *not* award the scholarship if a suitable application is not received.

3. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS (attach):

- a) A letter from a **School Leader** – endorsing your application and relating to the content and extent of your volunteerism and participation.
- b) A letter from a **Community Leader** – endorsing your application and relating to the content and extent of your volunteerism and participation.
- c) Copy of most recent **Transcript of Marks** and proof of post-secondary education enrolment.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT: May 1st. Drop off at the school office, addressed to the PAC Scholarship Committee.
