1. A one-page letter of application (typed) **summarizing:**
 - Introduction, include the name of the award. Introduce yourself and your family.
 - Future plans and goals. What will you be doing next year, in five years?
 - Involvement in your school and community. Accomplishments you are most proud of. (See page three of this document for help in organizing you statements)
 - Conclusion, make sure you have addressed the requirements of the award. What makes you a worthy candidate.
2. Two letters of reference (supporting school ability, character and accomplishments)
 - It is important that you understand how long it takes to write a good letter of reference. People are usually pleased to help you but they do need time. Please allow at least TWO WEEKS for the letter to be written.
3. Place a check mark in the box on the left-hand side of the school-based award(s) for which you wish to be considered. Submit this application along with any or other documents requested by the award donor to the school office.

Please note that if the same information is being requested multiple times, you only need to attach one copy as it will be used for any awards listed below that you are applying for.
4. Financial Need Statement (**only required if you are applying for a bursary**)
5. Transcripts - will be printed by the office.

Recipient of this award must submit proof of registration at a post-secondary institution.

❑ STUDENT FELLOWSHIP AWARD #2 - \$150.00

This award was established by the Logan Lake Secondary School students' council to assist a deserving student needing financial assistance to further his/her education. The applicants must indicate their contribution to the athletic, music, yearbook, student's council or other major programs in the school. Applicants must currently be graduating from Logan Lake Secondary School. The recipient of this award must submit proof of registration at a post-secondary institution.

Letter of Application, Copy of Marks, Resume (focus on school activities)

❑ LLSS GRAD 2019 PERSEVERANCE AWARD - \$500.00

On behalf of the 2019 Graduating class, we are pleased to present a bursary in the amount of \$500.00 to a student who may not have the highest grades but who consistently works to the best of his/her abilities and continues to do so throughout the year. Someone who is an active participant within their community and to someone who is wanting to attend a post secondary school within 2 years of receiving this award. Recipient must provide proof of registration to a post secondary institution within 2 years after graduation.

Letter of Application (including postsecondary plans)

❑ KAMLOOPS PRINCIPALS VICE-PRINCIPALS ASSOCIATION - \$250.00

One award will be issued to a Grade 12 student who is currently graduating from Logan Lake Secondary School. This award is based on Academic Achievement and Citizenship. Preference will be given to students pursuing a post-secondary career in Education, but other vocations will also be considered. Proof of payment for semester one of tuition or receipt of books purchased

will be required before the award will be issued. We ask that the recipient acknowledge receipt of their scholarship by providing a letter to our association.

❑ KAMLOOPS THOMPSON TEACHERS ASSOCIATION - SCHOOL AWARD - \$500

Open to all Logan Lake Secondary Students pursuing a post-secondary education.

❑ KAMLOOPS HONDA BURSARY - \$500

One award to graduating students from **each** secondary school in School District 73.

Applicant must show evidence of the following in a covering letter: Community and/or school involvement, academic standing of C+ or better (attach most recent transcript), must be attending Thompson Rivers University (trades, technical or academic and attach copy of TRU registration), must have financial need, bursary is for any program, career, academic or trade. Letter of Application, please indicate future education interests.

The TRU Foundation distributes this award after September.

❑ NICOLA VALLEY INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY – 1 X \$1,000.00

Qualifications for the award include:

- The student must have received a C+ within the last academic year.
- The student must be actively involved in either their community or secondary school community, demonstrate leadership abilities.
- The student plans on attending NVIT in any program at the post-secondary level (100-level or higher) in a full-time course load (80% minimum) within 15 months of graduation.

The award will be released in two disbursements (\$500 in October and \$500 in February, dependent upon achieving a minimum program GPA in the fall semester after the add/drop dates). If the student is sponsored, cheques will be made directly to the student after the add/drop dates of each semester.
