- #17. PAC will have a section on new site. Will include minutes and meeting dates.

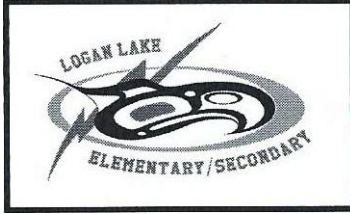
### Business
