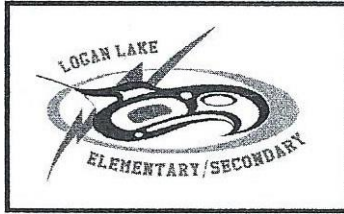
Business

3 District Bus Safety Training - All K-7 students in the SD received education on bus safety. Students learned about expectations while riding the school bus and participated in a practice evacuation.

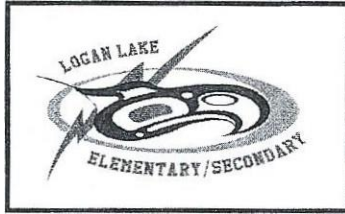

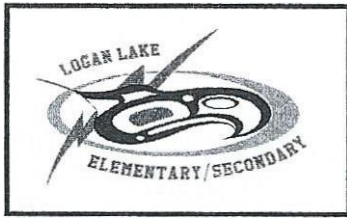


Principal's Report- October 2018

- 9) Orange Shirt Day- Many of our students wore Orange shirts on Friday Sept. 28th. This day grew out of *Phyllis' story* of having her shiny new orange shirt taken away on her first day of residential school at the Mission. The date was chosen because it is the time of year in which children were taken from their homes to residential schools. It was an opportunity to set the stage for anti-racism and anti-bullying policies for the coming school year.



- 10) Aboriginal Educator- our school is in process of hiring an aboriginal educator after Trish Rainville has transferred to Merritt. It is our hope that we will have one working in our school and making contact with families soon.
- 11) Bard on the Beach - Our senior students went to Bard on the Beach on Sept 20 -21 to experience a play and take in several cultural events.
