



LOGAN LAKE COMMUNITY FOREST BURSARY – GUIDELINES

The Logan Lake Community Forest Corporation (LLCF) is awarding two (2) \$750 bursaries for students in Logan Lake who, in addition to a reasonable level of academic success, have contributed to the school and/or community in a meaningful way and are pursuing post-secondary education.

ELIGIBILITY

Bursaries are available to all graduating students from Logan Lake Secondary School (LLSS) or distance/home schooled students living in Logan Lake, and will be starting post-secondary studies within one year of graduation.

QUALIFICATIONS

Students that demonstrate the following are eligible to apply:

1. **Academic Effort** – B grade average or better
2. **Involvement/Volunteerism** – demonstrated community and/or school spirit, through teams, clubs, school activities, volunteering, or community service
3. **Employment Experience** – outline past and present employment, and future aspirations
4. **Continuing Education** – upon acceptance into a post-secondary institute, and entering into:
 - a. Forestry-related studies,
 - b. Environmental studies,
 - c. Trades and Technology studies, or
 - d. Other studies.

SELECTION

Bursaries are awarded according to the above criteria and at the discretion of the LLCFC in coordination with the LLSS staff and principal.

DATE OF SUBMISSION

Applications must be received **no later than May 15th, 2019**.

a) Letter from a **School Leader** endorsing your application and relating to the content and extent of your volunteerism and participation.

b) Letter from a **Community Leader** endorsing your application and relating to the content and extent of your volunteerism and participation.

c) Copy of most recent **Transcript of Marks**.

d) Proof of **Post-Secondary Education Enrollment**.
