The Logan Lake Community Forest Corporation (LLCFC) is proud to be awarding a **Harry Holmquist Memorial Bursary** of \$1,500 for students in Logan Lake. The purpose of the bursary is to reward student who in addition to a reasonable level of academic success, display good character and a strong work ethic and have contributed to the community in a meaningful way through volunteerism and/or experience in forestry.

ELIGIBILITY

Bursaries are available to all graduating students from Logan Lake Secondary School (LLSS) or distance/home schooled students living in Logan Lake, and will be starting post-secondary studies within one year of graduation.

QUALIFICATIONS

Students that demonstrate the following are eligible to apply:

1. **Involvement/Volunteerism** – community involvement through volunteering, community service, or employment within forestry activities
2. **Employment Experience** – good character and work ethic, and able to describe how volunteer and/or forestry experiences impacted you and contributed to your future direction
3. **Continuing Education** – upon acceptance into a post-secondary institute

SELECTION

Bursaries are awarded according to the above criteria and at the discretion of LLCFC in coordination with the Holmquist family and LLSS staff and principal.

DATE OF SUBMISSION

Applications must be received **no later than May 15th, 2019**.
