BASIS FOR SELECTION:

Payable in two equal installments, one in September, one in January. Each installment will be given only after proof of payment for tuition and/or textbooks is received. Applicant's choice of study may be academic or vocational.

Applicant must have minimum entrance level grades for admittance to post-secondary institution. Applicant must be a first time Grade 12 graduate. Applicant must graduate from Logan Lake Secondary School. Applicant's choice of post-secondary institution is limited to anywhere in Canada or the U.S.A. Applicant must show past and current commitments to school and community volunteer organizations. The applicant must submit an essay on the topic listed below. Applicant must enroll in a two-year minimum program. Applicant must attend a post-secondary institution full time.
