

LOGAN LAKE STAFF SURVEY RESULTS & NEXT STEPS

November 12, 2024

Dear Logan Lake Parents,

Thank you again for sharing your feedback over the past few weeks about the potential for moving Grades 5 and 6 students back to the elementary school. As a reminder of the consultation process and results so far, please visit the Community Consultation webpage [here](#).

Throughout this process, parents have asked to know what staff most preferred. Last week, Logan Lake staff participated in a survey to share their thoughts and feedback. We received responses from support staff and teachers of all grade levels.

The quantitative results of the most recent staff survey are:

The majority of Logan Lake staff (60.9%) recommended reconfiguring over 2 years and not to move students: This would mean that current Grade 4 students would stay for Grade 5, students would be at the elementary school in September 2025 and remain there for Grade 6 in 2026. No other students would move.

39.1% of staff recommended reconfiguring at one time: This would mean that both Grade 5 and 6 students would be at the elementary school as of September 2025. This means that current Grade 4 students would stay for Grade 5 and current Grade 5 students would move to the elementary school for Grade 6 in September 2025.

Only 13% of staff did not recommend a reconfiguration: This option would leave the grades as they are with Grades 5 and 6 staying at the secondary school and K-4 staying at the elementary school.

The qualitative results of the staff survey are:

Support for Grade 5 and 6 moving to elementary (16 comments): Focused on supporting the move of Grade 5 and 6 to elementary school for the leadership opportunities, extracurricular opportunities, playground access, and the avoidance of more mature, often negative influences.

Support for a phased-in approach (4 comments): Having grades 4 and 5 stay provides time for both students and staff to adjust to the change including practical aspects such as schedules, knowing teaching assignments, and settling into the change.

Specific grades preferred (4 comments): K-5 is reasonable and leaves the opportunity for another Kindergarten room and a Grade 6/7 combined class in the secondary school. All comments focused on a K-5 configuration as most desirable.

Staff choice and support (2 comments): Some concerns about not being able to transfer between buildings without the worry of having to post to a job and about whether having more students in the elementary would cause less support.

Support the move now (1): Moving everyone at once seems easier.

Should be a District decision dependent on space (1).
