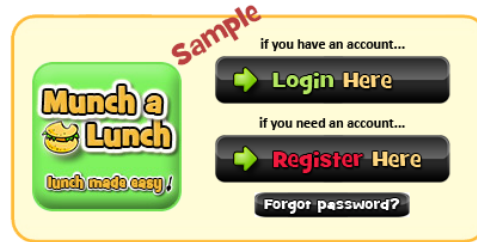
Hot lunch is now open for the winter to spring break session. We offer hot lunch three times a week.
